



ILLINOIS FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE LABOR COUNCIL RECOGNITION AWARD

The Labor Council Executive Board announced the fifteenth annual Illinois Fraternal Order of Police Labor Council Recognition Award. The award is intended to honor those law enforcement personnel and criminal justice professionals who have performed their duties with distinction and/or valor.

Candidates for the award may be nominated by any Labor Council member, but candidates do not have to be union members to be nominated. The application must state the name of the nominee, his/her employer, the name of the person(s) submitting the nomination, and a narrative explanation as to why the nominee is deserving of consideration for the award.

All nominations will be reviewed by the Executive Board's Membership Committee and voted for approval by the entire Executive Board. The award(s) will be announced and presented each year at the Labor Council Annual Meeting. There is no limit to the number of awards presented each year.

The award(s) will be presented in March at the 2017 Labor Council Annual Meeting. **Nominations must be received by January 17, 2017** at the Labor Council's Springfield office. Please mail or fax the nomination to the attention of the Executive Board Membership Committee.
